Next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. During Holy Week, the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum begin on Thursday with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. This Mass is one of the most beautiful liturgies of the year, when we commemorate the Last Supper and re-enact the washing of the feet. This liturgy also reminds us of the great gift Jesus left us, the gift of the Eucharist, His Body and Blood. After this Mass on Holy Thursday we have the opportunity to spend some time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in a chapel set aside for quiet prayer and adoration. I would like to encourage you first, to attend the Holy Thursday Mass, secondly, to sign up for Adoration following the Mass, and finally to offer your feet for the washing. We are hoping to have Adoration until 10:00 pm on Thursday evening. Sign-up sheets for Adoration and washing of the feet may be found at each church entrance door. Please sign up today and plan on attending and participating in the Holy Thursday evening Mass.

Also, we need lectors, extra altar servers, and ministers of Communion for the evening Masses on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday evening. Please speak to Father Bill if you can help, or sign up in the sacristy after Mass. I thank you. Your help is needed and appreciated.
