Diocesan Synod Update: We have been asked, along with all the parishes in the diocese, to conduct a second round of parish consultation in preparation for the diocesan synod. In the first phase of consultation, more than 70 listening sessions took place, and over 1,600 Catholics from around the diocese offered over 2,600 comments. The Inland See, an insert in next weekend's bulletin, will list the **top seven themes** drawn from those thousands of comments. We are asking you to look at and to consider those themes in preparation for giving your input at Masses on the weekend of April 14-15. You will be asked to prioritize the themes and allowed to give your comments. Copies of the Summary of Round One of the parish consultation will also be made available for those who wish to read it.

Rosary for Healing and Protection on Facebook
