Diocesan Synod Parish Consultation:

We have been asked, along with all the parishes in the diocese, to conduct a second round of parish consultation in preparation for the diocesan synod. In the first phase of consultation, more than 70 listening sessions took place, and over 1,600 Catholics from around the diocese offered over 2,600 comments. The insert found in today's bulletin, lists the **top seven themes** drawn from those thousands of comments. We are asking you to give your input today by filling out this form and prioritizing the themes, ranking them 1-7, in order of importance, with one (1) being the most important and seven (7) being the least important.
