## 2018 Bishop's Annual Appeal

“Every good and perfect gift is from above” (James, 1:17). You likely have received at least one request from Bishop Coyne requesting your support of the Bishop's Annual Appeal. We are getting closer to our goal and ask that you prayerfully consider the request and respond generously. In addition to monies distributed for charitable works, such as Vermont Catholic Charities' Emergency Aid, the diocese is a valuable resource to all parishes, both large and small. St. Patrick Parish is now at 54% of our pledge goal (\$7,150 toward goal of \$13,179), and St. Anthony-St. George is at 89% of pledge goal (\$3,239 toward goal of \$3,618). Thank you to all who have participated so far. Pledge cards may be found at the church entrances for those who wish to use them.

**Annual Diocesan Family Mass:** The Mass will be held at St. Anne's Shrine in Isle LaMotte on Sunday, July 8th at 12:15 pm. Following the Mass, to be celebrated by Bishop Coyne, visitors may picnic on the shrine grounds or on the shore of Lake Champlain. Cost for barbeque is \$10.95 for adults, \$6.95 for children 12 and under; and for families of four or more (two adults and two or more children) \$35.00. **Independence Day**--also known as The Fourth of July--has been a federal holiday in the United States since 1941, but the tradition of Independence Day celebrations goes back to the 18<sup>th</sup> century and the American Revolution. On July 2, 1776, the Continental Congress voted in favor of independence, and two days later delegates from the thirteen colonies adopted the Declaration of Independence, a historic document drafted by Thomas Jefferson. From 1776 to the present day, July 4<sup>th</sup> has been celebrated as the birth of American Independence, with festivities ranging from fireworks, parades and concerts to more casual family gatherings and barbeques.
