Priests' Retreat: Father Bill and about twenty other priests of our diocese will be making a retreat this coming week. This will be held at the Lake Morey Inn, where we've had our annual Presbyteral Assembly for the past number of years. Bishop Coyne will be the retreat master. This will be our first time at Lake Morey in the winter so our extracurricular activities will have to be adjusted. No golf, tennis, boating, or swimming in the lake!

Catholic Town Meetings: Bishop Coyne has scheduled a number of town meetings and listening sessions around the state. He wants to hear what people are thinking and wishes to continue to promote full transparency about Catholic matters in Vermont. These sessions are being held in six different locations around the state, and the first one was held in St. Albans this past Thursday evening. If you missed it, others will be held at Holy Family, 4 Prospect Street, Essex Junction on Tuesday, January 22, and St. John Vianney, 160 Hinesburg Road, South Burlington on Thursday, January 31, both from 6:00 – 7:30 pm. All are welcome.

Annual Diocesan Respect Life Mass: Saturday, January 26, at 9:30 am at St. Augustine Church in Montpelier with Bishop Coyne as Celebrant, followed by refreshments in the church hall. At 10:45 am. attendees will prayerfully walk with Vermont Right to Life to the State House for a group photo on the State House steps. Vermont Right to Life will host a program inside the State House featuring prayer, announcements and guest speaker Ann McElhinney. The event concludes with refreshments and ends by 2:30 pm.

World Marriage Day 2019 Celebration with Bishop Coyne: The celebration of World Marriage Day in the Diocese of Burlington will take place on Sunday, February 3, 2019, at the 10:00 AM Mass at St. Joseph's Cathedral in Burlington with recognition being given to those couples celebrating their milestone anniversaries in the year 2019 (5, 10, 15 etc...). Couples can also choose to be recognized in their parish and receive a certificate on the following Sunday, February 10th. Call to Discipleship: Each year Bishop Coyne has chosen a particular theme for our diocese. In the past three years we have celebrated the Year of Mercy in 2016, the Year of Creation in 2017, and the Year of the Family this past year. As a follow-up to the recently held Diocesan Synod, the bishop has designated this coming year of 2019 as the "Call to Discipleship."

A Note About Cold and Flu Season: The sign of Peace has been an integral and valued part of the worship of the church for centuries in the form of a kiss of peace or handshake. As we enter this cold and flu season, it is important to recognize that some people are especially susceptible to the viruses that can be spread by contact and that some immune systems are very sensitive. Please understand that some people may choose not to shake hands during the Sign of Peace, but might simply greet you with a smile. Also, please use common sense and good judgment concerning Mass attendance if you are ill. If you do decide to come to church for Mass, please remember that frequent and thorough hand-washing, refraining from physical contact during the Sign of Peace, and refraining from receiving communion from the Chalice can help prevent the spread of germs.
