There will be a Work Bee at St. Patrick Cemetery on June 22<sup>nd</sup> at 9:00 am. All are welcome to lend a hand.





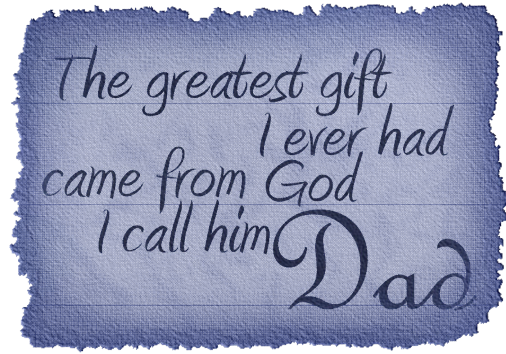
