**5-Day Silent Retreat:** The Society of St. Edmund will be conducting a 5-Day Silent Retreat in the Ignatian tradition from June 23<sup>rd</sup> to June 28<sup>th</sup> at St. Anne's Shrine in Isle La Motte. Using principles from the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola, retreatants will be invited to contemplate scriptural passages, celebrate daily Eucharist and meet with a Spiritual Director each day. Spiritual Directors will serve as companions and co-discerners of the Spirit during the retreat.
