 Your shirt at work. You likely have received at least one request from Bishop Christopher Coyne requesting your support of the Bishop's Annual Appeal. We are getting closer to our appeal goal and ask that you prayerfully consider the request and respond generously. In addition to monies distributed for charitable works, such as Vermont Catholic Charities' Emergency Aid, the Diocese is a valuable resource to all parishes, both large and small. **As of July 8th, St. Patrick Parish is now at 78% of our pledge goal (\$10,216 toward goal of \$13,179), and St. Anthony-St. George is now at 111% of pledge goal (\$4,095 toward goal of \$3,686).** Pledge cards may be found at the church entrances for those who wish them.

**Catholic Leadership Institute Update:**

Completion of the Disciple Maker Index Surveys in March helped to provide a snapshot of our parishes as they presently exist. A total of 79 surveys were completed. **This past week members of our "Action Plan Writing Team" met again to prepare to give to you the results of the Disciple Maker Index Survey, and to use the results of the survey to work on a parish action plan.** This parish action plan is intended to support the pastor in coming up with priorities for the parish with one or two goals each that are personalized to the parish community but also align with the goals and priorities of the recent Diocesan Synod. Implementation of a parish action plan is expected to take place over a three-year period. Members of the Action Plan Writing Team include: Alfonso Capone, Mike Morse, Mary Schreindorfer, Linda Watson, and Father Bill.

**From the Office of Youth and Young Adult Ministry:**

Attention Catholic Young Adults ages 18-39! We want to connect with you! And we want to help connect you to others Catholic young adults here in the Diocese of Burlington. Please give us your basic information so that we can be in communication with you about Young Adult offerings here in Vermont. Forms to help you give us your information may be found on the tables at the church entrances. Please take a moment to fill one out!

**Church Maintenance:** Over the last several months the stewardship committee has been reviewing the church properties to determine what work was necessary to maintain the buildings and grounds. Deteriorating concrete and interior walls of the church basement has lead the committee to take action to stop future damage to the church structure. Later this summer, work will begin to address drainage issues around the basement entry to the church and in front of the rectory garage. This will include removing some pavement, adding new drain tile and replacing some of the base of the current driveway. The plan is to add additional pavement up to the current location of the dumpster and the handicap parking area. Work should be completed by early fall.

**Fiscal Year Ends:** Our fiscal year ended on June 30. St. Patrick Sunday Collections totaled \$65,356 toward the budget goal of \$65,000, and St. Anthony-St. George Sunday collections totaled \$19,673 toward the budget goal of \$20,000. We will soon be giving you Year End Financial Reports. Also, we will be working on budgets for the new 2019-2020 fiscal year. Once the budgets have been finalized, we'll be able to post new weekly goals for Sunday offering in the bulletin.
