 Your shirt at work. You likely have received at least one request from Bishop Christopher Coyne requesting your support of the Bishop's Annual Appeal. We are getting closer to our appeal goal and ask that you prayerfully consider the request and respond generously. The Diocese is a valuable resource to all parishes, both large and small. **As of July 8th, St. Patrick Parish is now at 81% of our pledge goal (\$10,671 toward goal of \$13,179), and St. Anthony-St. George is now at 112% of pledge goal (\$4,140 toward goal of \$3,686).** Pledge cards may be found at the church entrances for those who wish them.

Bishop Robert Barron, founder of Word on Fire Catholic Ministries and Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, has offered a reflection on today's church, Letter to a Suffering Church. Below are words from the preface of this book. Free copies are available today for those who may wish one.

Letter to a Suffering Church: "This book is a *cri de Coeur*, a cry from the heart. I am a lifelong Catholic, and I've been a priest for thirty-three years and a bishop for four years. I've dedicated my life to the Church. The sexual abuse scandal has been for me, for millions of other Catholics, and especially for the victim-survivors, lacerating. I have written this book for my fellow Catholics who feel, understandably, demoralized, scandalized, angry beyond words, and ready to quit. What I finally urge my brothers and sisters in the Church to do is to stay and fight and to do so on behalf of themselves and their families, but especially on behalf of those who have suffered so grievously at the hands of wicked men. Of course, I'm also happy if those outside the Church find some illumination in these chapters as well. I am not speaking in the name of my brother bishops, or of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, or of the Vatican. I have no authority whatsoever to do so. I am speaking in my own name, as a Catholic, a priest, and a bishop. My prayer is that these reflections might encourage Catholics who are attempting to navigate today in very choppy waters."

Church Maintenance: Over the last several months the stewardship committee has been reviewing the church properties to determine what work was necessary to maintain the buildings and grounds. Deteriorating concrete and interior walls of the church basement has lead the committee to take action to stop future damage to the church structure. Later this summer, work will begin to address drainage issues around the basement entry to the church and in front of the rectory garage. This will include removing some pavement, adding new drain tile and replacing some of the base of the current driveway. The plan is to add additional pavement up to the current location of the dumpster and the handicap parking area. Work should be completed by early fall.
